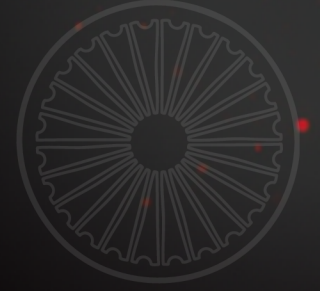

RULES & REGULATIONS

(AS PER WORLD KARATE COMPETITION RULES)

1. General Guidelines

- The 2nd Karate India Senior National Karate Championship 2026-27 will be conducted strictly in accordance with the latest World Karate Rules and Regulations.
- All competitors, coaches, and officials must be registered members of Karate India and affiliated state/union territory associations.
- Participants must possess a valid identity card and age proof certificate at the time of verification.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make decisions on all matters not explicitly covered by these rules.

2. Event Disciplines

- KATA (Forms) [18+ to <21 Years for U-21 & 16+ for Senior].
- Individual and Team Kata events will follow World Karate guidelines.
- All Kata events will be conducted using the Electronic Kata Scoring System.
- Repetition of Kata is not allowed, except in the final rounds as per International amendments.
- KUMITE (Sparring)
- Bouts will be conducted on International standard 8m x 8m tatami.
- Duration of the bout will follow International standards:
 - 3 minutes for Men & 3 minutes for women categories.
- Weight categories will be as per official World Karate / Karate India guidelines.
 - Mens: -50kg/ -55kg/ -60kg / -67kg/ -75kg/ -84kg/ +84kg
 - Womens: -45kg/ -50kg/ -55kg/ -61kg/ -68kg/ +68kg
- Team Kumite (4 Members in Womens Team & 8 Members in Mens Team)

RULES & REGULATIONS

(AS PER WORLD KARATE COMPETITION RULES)

3. Equipment & Uniform

- All competitors must wear International-approved white karate gi with Karate India logo/association badge.
- Protective equipment (International-approved) is mandatory:
 - Mouth guard
 - Hand protectors (red/blue as per AKA/AO designation)
 - Shin and foot protectors (red/blue)
 - Chest protector (mandatory for female athletes)
 - Body protector
- Groin guards are optional but recommended.

4. Refereeing & Judging

- All matches will be officiated by qualified and accredited referees recognized by Karate India & World Karate.
- The Referee Commission will have the authority to interpret the rules in case of any dispute.
- The decisions of the Referee Panel shall be final and binding.

5. Conduct & Discipline

- Competitors and coaches must maintain discipline, respect, and sportsmanship throughout the championship.
- Unsporting behavior, protests, or interference with officials will result in penalties or disqualification.
- Only officially accredited coaches will be allowed in the competition area during bouts.

RULES & REGULATIONS

(AS PER WORLD KARATE COMPETITION RULES)

6. Protest & Appeals

- Protests must be submitted in writing to the Appeals Jury within 5 minutes of the incident.
- A protest fee (as determined by the organizing committee) must accompany the written appeal.
- The decision of the Appeals Jury shall be final and cannot be challenged further.

7. Medical & Safety

- A qualified medical team will be present at all times during the event.
- Any athlete declared unfit by the medical officer shall not be permitted to continue.
- The Organizing Committee shall not be held responsible for any injury sustained during the competition; participants compete at their own risk.

8. Awards & Recognition

- 1 Gold, 1 Silver, and 2 Bronze medals will be awarded in each event category.
- Overall Championship Trophies will be presented based on cumulative points.
- Certificates of participation will be awarded to all registered competitors.

9. Miscellaneous

- All participants must report for weigh-in and registration at the scheduled time.
- Late reporting or absence will result in automatic disqualification.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule or rules if required for smooth conduct of the event.

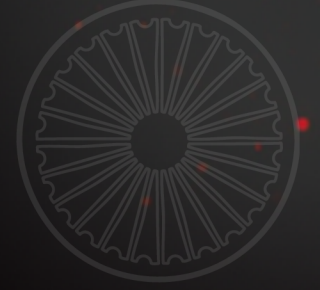

REGISTRATION

1. Eligibility Criteria

- Open to registered members of Karate India.
- Participants must represent their recognized State / UT / Institutional Karate Association affiliated with Karate India.
- Each competitor must possess a valid ID card and proof of age (Aadhaar / Birth Certificate / Passport / School ID).
- Competitor must possess the Certificate of their State Participation
- Age will be considered as on 29th May 2026.
- All competitors must be medically fit to participate.

2. Entry Fee Structure

| Particulars | Fee (INR) |
|---|-----------------------|
| Championship Fee (including Accommodation & Food) | ₹2000 per participant |
| Extra Event (Kata / Kumite / Team Kata) | ₹500 per event |

Includes:

3 nights' accommodation (29th–31st May, 2026)

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner during the championship

Notes:

- Entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- All payments must be made through the respective State Association, which will remit the consolidated amount to the Organizing Committee.
- No on-spot entries will be accepted without state verification.

REGISTRATION

3. Medical & Safety

- A fully equipped Medical Team and First Aid Unit will be available throughout the event.
- All competitors must wear approved protective gear as per International Karate Rules.
- Serious injuries will be handled immediately by the Championship Medical Officer.

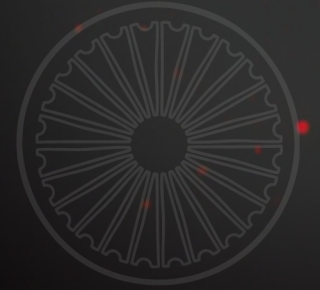
4. Registration Process

- All registrations must be completed online only through the provided official ID, Password and given link.
- Entries submitted by individuals will not be accepted.
- All entries must be submitted through the respective State / UT / Institutional Karate Association Secretary.
- The Organizing Committee will confirm registration after verifying eligibility and payment through official communication.
- The State Secretary or President must submit a complete list of participants on the official letterhead

5. Important Instructions

- Incomplete forms or missing information will result in rejection.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to verify eligibility and disqualify any athlete for misconduct or false documentation.
- Participants must maintain discipline, decorum, and sportsmanship at all times.
- Damage to accommodation property will be the responsibility of the concerned State Association.
- All teams must strictly follow the reporting and check-in schedule provided before the event.

HOW TO REACH THE VENUE

About the Venue

Daly College, established in 1882, is one of India's most prestigious and historic educational institutions. Located in the heart of Indore, the college boasts world-class sports infrastructure, lush green surroundings, and excellent facilities, making it an ideal venue for a national-level championship.

The campus is easily accessible by road, rail, and air, and is well-connected to all major cities across India.

By Air – Indore Airport (Devi Ahilya Bai Holkar Airport)

- Distance from Daly College: Approximately 8 km (20 minutes)
- Nearest Major Airport: Devi Ahilya Bai Holkar International Airport, Indore (IDR)
- Regular flights operate from major Indian cities such as Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, Hyderabad, Bengaluru, and Ahmedabad.
- Transport from Airport: Prepaid taxis, app-based cabs (Ola/Uber), and auto-rickshaws are easily available to reach Daly College.

By Train – Indore Junction Railway Station

- Distance from Daly College: Around 3.5 km (10 minutes)
- Indore Junction is a major railway hub with frequent trains from cities like Delhi, Bhopal, Jaipur, Mumbai, and Ahmedabad.
- Nearby Stations:
 - Indore Junction (INDB) – 3.5 km
 - Laxmibai Nagar (LMNR) – 5 km
 - Dewas Junction (DWX) – 40 km

HOW TO REACH THE VENUE

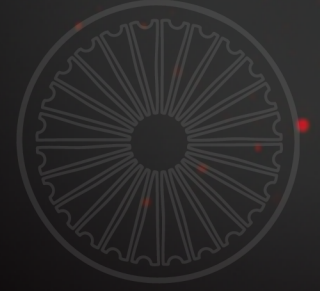
By Road – Well Connected Network

- Indore is connected via NH-52 and NH-47 to major cities in Madhya Pradesh and neighboring states.
- Approximate Road Distances:
 - Bhopal – 190 km
 - Ujjain – 55 km
 - Ahmedabad – 400 km
 - Nagpur – 440 km
 - Jaipur – 520 km
- Regular Intercity Buses and Private Coaches are available to and from Indore.
- The Sarwate Bus Stand and Gangwal Bus Stand are the main terminals, both located within 5 km of Daly College.

Local Transportation

- Indore offers convenient local transport options such as:
 - App-based Cabs: Ola, Uber
 - Auto Rickshaws & E-Rickshaws available across the city
 - City Buses connecting major points to the Daly College area
- For teams staying at official accommodations, directions and assistance will be provided by the Organizing Committee Help Desk.

Travel & Packing Essentials (Participants and officials are advised to carry):

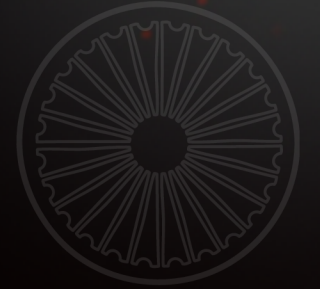
- Original Identity Proof (Aadhaar / Passport / School ID)
- Medical Fitness Certificate (if not submitted earlier)
- Personal Toiletries and Towels
- Karate Gi (Uniform) and approved protective gear
- Light winter clothing for evenings
- Personal water bottle, sports shoes, and energy supplements if required
- A padlock or name tag for personal luggage

Local Conduct & Guidelines

- All participants are ambassadors of their State / Association and must maintain discipline and decorum.
- Avoid roaming outside campus without prior permission of the team manager.
- Respect venue rules and maintain cleanliness at all times.
- Alcohol, smoking, and use of prohibited substances are strictly forbidden on campus and accommodation premises.
- Carry a copy of your ID card at all times for security checks.
